- COTS - >\$10k and available on the Grainger / GSA catalog – Grainger 4PL GSA contract.
- MRO Prime Vendor >\$10k – Equipment and supplies related to Maintenance, Repair and Operations of a Facility.
- COTS (and slightly modified COTS) - >\$10k - <\$250k Competitive (brand name or equal) and NOT available on the Grainger / GSA catalog or VIA MRO – SAT Supply Procurement Program (S2P2) Fort Drum.
- Heavy Equipment COTS – DLA HEPP Program.
- Everything else - ACC-RI (Does not fit any of the above / manufactured to a drawing / NON-COTS)
 - Regional industry
 - Educational institutions


